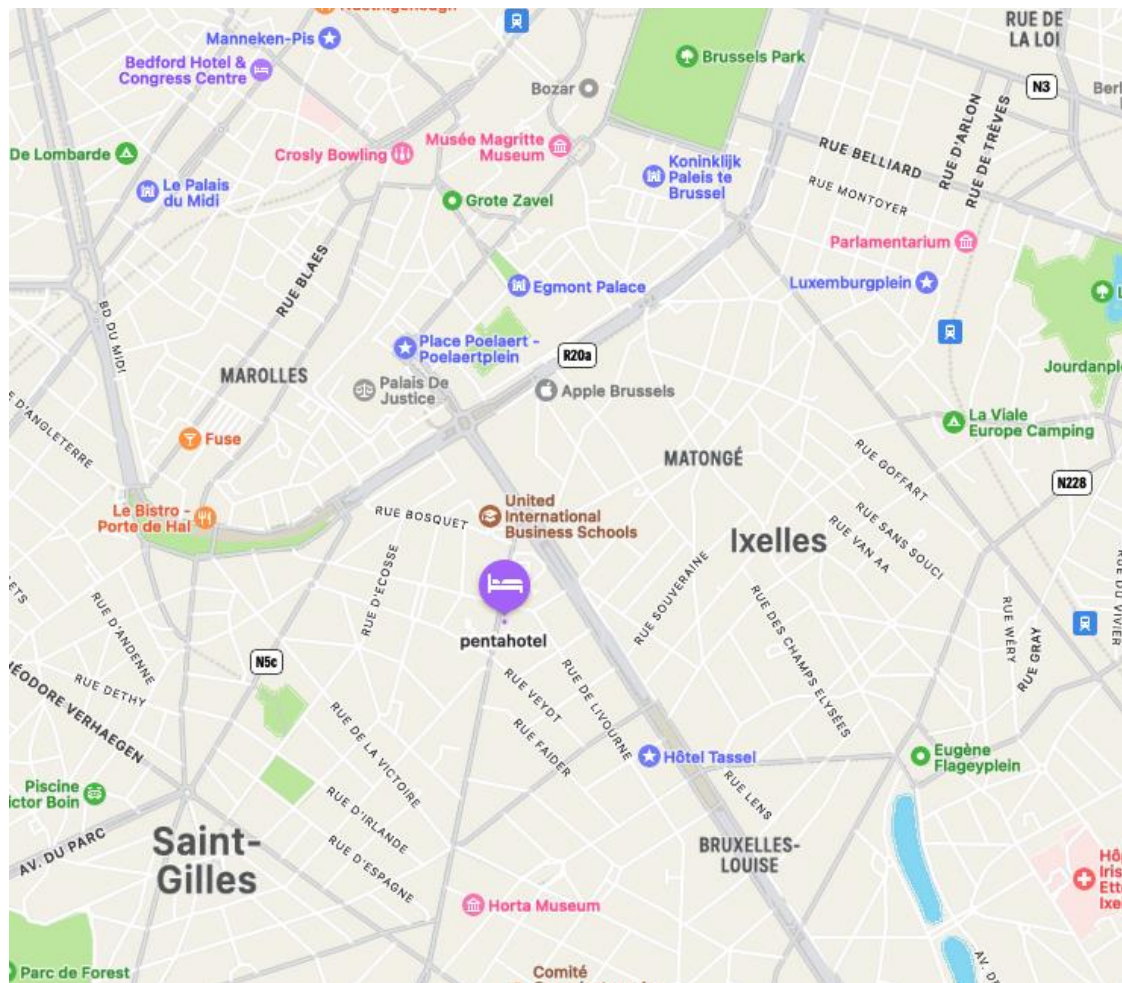
Prices are €105/night for a single room, and €115/night twin share. Currently there is an option to book a double room for €90.80. We therefore encourage early booking and room sharing.
