

Fuengirola has a very rich history. Before the tourism boom in the 60s it was a small fishing village and that was its main source of income. Now it is the most popular resort on the Costa Del Sol, as proven by the Hotel & Leisure Society of Malaga. In Fuengirola there are many attractions such as;

Castilo Sohail- which was built in the 12<sup>th</sup> century. In 1485 it was occupied by Christian armies battling against the Nasrid Kingdom of Granada.

Bio Park Fuengirola- A fantastic zoo where the animals are very well looked after, a great day out for everyone.

Miramar Shopping Mall- One of the biggest shopping malls in Andalucia, containg over 100 shops, a 6 screen cinema & a Go Kart Track on the roof.

Train Line- We are very lucky in Fuengirola as we are the end of the line on the trainline, the trains run every 20 minutes and you can easily visit most of the resorts along the costa including, Benalmadena, Torremolinos & Malaga City, which all contain English speaking AA meetings.

There are many hotel options in Fuengirola;

Hotel Angela,Hotel Yaramar,Occidental Hotel,Jabega Hotel,Hostel El Cid,Hostel Marbella,Hotel Agur, Hostel Italia, Hotel Itaca.

There will be a minibus service available twice day leaving from the hotel, the drop off points will be Miramar Shopping Mall, Fuengirola Train Station & Lux Mundi.
