Getting Around

- If you travel by plane From Munich Airport to NH München Messe
 - o Taxi (Free now or SIXT ride) From 61€ to 89€
 - Public transportation: S1 exit at 'Ostbahnhof', switch to Bus 190 exit at 'Zamdorf Siedlung' then 2 minute walk to the hotel
 - o Car pool options may also be available please contact Sarah V.
- If you arrive by train From Munich Main Station to NH München Messe
 - o Taxi (Free now or SIXT ride)
 - Public transportation: S6 exit at 'Berg am Laim', switch to Bus 190 exit at
 'Zamdorf Siedlung' then 2 minute walk to the hotel
- Public Transportation in General
