Booking your room at Absolutum Hotel

Room reservations can be made by contacting Katerina Vrbová at vrbova@absolutumhotel.cz or on +420 739 069 636 using the code Prague2026. The hotel has kindly reserved rooms with a special rate for us under this code.



The room options are as follows:

Superior SGL room: 90 EUR per room/night/breakfast + 2 EUR city tax per person/night

Superior DBL room: 102 EUR per room/night/breakfast + 2 EUR city tax per person/night

All DBL rooms can also be shared and be used with 2 single beds.

If you are a Regional Officer, please keep in mind the [CER reimbursement guidelines](#) when booking your accommodation. (As Region Rep you may want to check with your Intergroup about reimbursement guidelines)

Getting Around

- *If you travel by plane - From Prague Airport to Absolutum Hotel*
 - Public transportation: The most convenient route is using the AE (Airport Express) that departs from outside Terminal 1 and 2. Unfortunately you cannot use normal public transport tickets, but you can pay the driver 50CZK or €2 – they will accept euros. This terminates at Prague's main station Hlavní Nádraží where you can take the metro 3 stops to the hotel. The metro is the red line (C) direction Letňany exit at 'Nádraží Holešovice', then it is a 3-minute walk to the hotel.
- *If you arrive by train or bus into the main station Hlavní Nádraží –*
 - Take the metro red line (C) direction Letňany exit at 'Nádraží Holešovice', then it is a 3-minute walk to the hotel.



- *Public Transportation in General*

- Public transport is the quickest and most affordable way to get around Prague. The simple tickets last for 30 or 90 minutes and need to be time stamped when you enter. They can be purchased from machines in the central station, but the app 'pid litacka' is worth downloading for journey planning and ticket purchase
- Please note you still have to activate your ticket once you have purchased it in the app. Purchased tickets can be used to travel by all means of local public transport including trams. A 72 hour ticket is often the most convenient option. For more info [click here](#).
